Comment from Peter Hille (Program Coordinator):

This is a proposed program for meetings and events to June 30th. There may be some changes to this, about which you will be duly notified. Two key themes of President Sue's year have been arts and the environment which the above program of events will support.

Over the past several months we have combined with the Bowls Club for some really successful events – we will continue to explore possibilities with this partner and indeed with other current or potential partners (eg sports clubs, schools, local businesses). Certainly in the program to June 30 (specific dates to be determined) we will engage with CERES Environmental Centre & City of Yarra Libraries; we will set up an annual writers presentation (starting with prominent Melbourne author Andrea Goldsmith; we will expand our tax deductible scholarships program; we will explore strategies for enhancing our international projects centred on East Timor and the Tiwi Islands.
