### Meeting 7<sup>th</sup> October Speaker Peter Don

Peter gave an excellent overview about his work with the 'Rail Futures Institute', an advocacy group formed in 2013. He provided insight into the issues Melbourne faces with its fast growing population and outer urban sprawl. He informed us about, 'The Melbourne Rail Plan 2020-2050,' and other transport networks, which will link into a future grid system for Melbourne. He emphasized that the focus is on how to shape the city to be sustainable and more inclusive, while managing the disadvantages of fast growth. The Plan is to create an integrated system which will include tunnels for cross city access, extension of the train and tram networks, the development of new cross town corridors and the provision of more light rail capacity. Bike riding and walking were also included as transport modes in this integrated approach. The aim is to reduce the dependency of Melbourne commuters on their cars and to ensure outer suburban travellers have access to a dependable public transport system that will reduce the time taken for the daily commute. Peter's talk was excellent and it provided us with an informative and insightful view of Melbourne's transport needs in the future and the many options for possible development.

### Meeting 21<sup>st</sup> October

At this meeting we had the pleasure of inducting Wallace Lehmann as a new member of Fitzroy Rotary Club. We congratulate him on joining Rotary. Wallace spoke a little about his background and his career and how he is looking forward to making a contribution to the local community and the projects associated with Fitzroy Rotary.
