The first speaker for the month of October was Janet Etherington from Interplast, a non-profit organization associated with Rotary. Interplast involves teams of volunteers, plastic and reconstructive surgeons, anesthetists and nurses, and allied health professionals to provide life changing surgery and medical training in 17 countries across the Asia Pacific region. People who have a disability are more vulnerable to poverty than those who don't.

The second speaker for the month was Christopher Bennett, author of 'Roy Boy'.
