ROTARY CLUB PRESIDENT'S REPORT – SEPTEMBER 2025

Greetings everyone. Pat, Barry, Val, Wallace, Tony, Kevin, and I, together with friends from the U3A bowling group, enjoyed a great afternoon at the bowling club on Saturday to watch the Brisbane Lions defeat Geelong. Commiserations to Wallace, but otherwise, I believe most people were pleased with the result.

Thanks to Sue, Kevin, and Peter Don, who manned the Challenge Cup barbecue at the Richmond Soccer Pitch on 6 September 2025.

On Monday 8 September the Club was addressed by Gillian Opie, a neonatologist who we hope will become a member of our club in the not too distant future. Among Gillian's various attributes, she is an international board-certified lactation consultant, and the Victorian Government recently named a North East Link Tunnel boring machine in her honour as a local living legend.

On 22 September 2025, our club was addressed by Dave De Brincat, the CEO of WaterAid in Australia. Dave gave a tremendous talk explaining WaterAid's

Next Sunday, I'll be meeting with other Rotary presidents from our area with Gary Goldsmith, a leader in the district.

I have been approached by Jenny Farrar, a director on the Board of the Bendigo Community Bank, inviting our club to make an application for funds to assist the local schools, and that matter will come before the board on 6 October 2025.

welcome to apply, and in the eight years I've been in Rotary, I don't recall there ever being an election for any position.


